Online lecture held on cyber crime, challenges

An online lecture was delivered by Richa Jain, DSP Cyber Crime HQ Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh, on the topic CyberCrime & Cyber Challenges at LNCT College on 19 February.

The lecture was organized for the new batch of AI/MI and cyber security, first year students to enlighten the students about various online frauds, spams, and cyber-crimes.

Topics such as photo morphing, child pornography, cyber stalking, duplicity of online accounts, frauds with money transactions, privacy setting maintenance, authorization of apps while downloading, and secured

visits to websites etc were covered.

Richa Jain explained how a photo can be morphed and faces of some person can be replaced with the faces of another person, for this she said that, "one must always be aware of where their photos are being saved and sent. Anyone should be very alert while sharing their pictures."

She told how often people understand too late about the bullying that is caused online, like making fun of someone's body, color, appearance or even teasing them in terms of money, religion, and caste. People these days create fake accounts and use those fake ids to target their victim.
